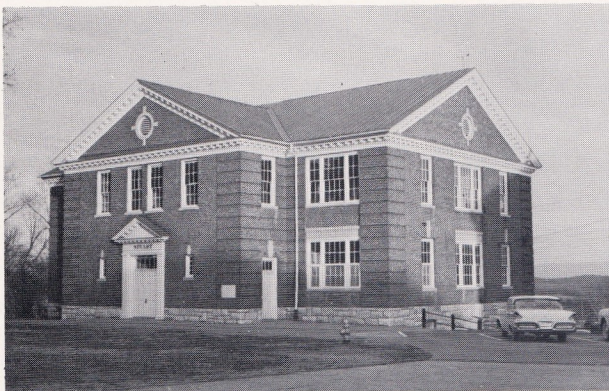
AROUND THE CAMPUS

Stuart Hall is a vocational building for metal and woodwork.



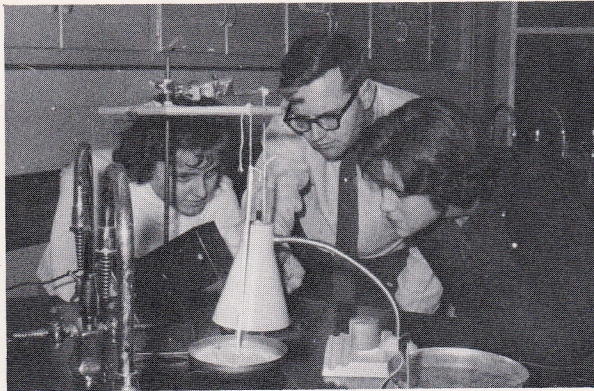
This is the front entrance of Byrd Hall where we started our early years.
