
The Virginia School For The Deaf Staunton, Virginia

#### Main Hall


Main Hall is the central structure of The Virginia School for the Deaf and the Blind. The cornerstone was laid on July 9, 1840. The building was completed in 1846. As originally designed, the main building was to be equally divided into the deaf school and the blind school which were to share common service facilities. The architect was Robert Cary Long of Baltimore, Maryland. The builder was William Donohoe of Albemarle, Virginia. All of the brick work is of the highest quality Flemish bond. The center of the building is marked by the large hexastyle Greek Doric pedimented portico. Main Hall contained all of the rooms necessary for residential students. There was a kitchen, a dining room and a washing room. There was a handsomely furnished parlor upon the first floor, and a fine library and large school rooms. Dormitories were on the second floor and in the attic story. From 1861 to 1865 it was used as a hospital for Confederate soldiers. Even now, reminders of those war years are etched on the window panes of the second floor where patients carved their initials on old glass.

Today Main Hall is used for administrative purposes and parts of the porches have been enclosed to provide additional office space. Guest rooms welcome beloved visitors.

It is listed as a Registered National Historic Landmark by the Department of the Interior and has recently been added to the Virginia Landmark Register.

## HISTORY OF THE MASON-DIXON BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT


The first annual Mason-Dixon Basketball tournament was held at the Virginia School for the Deaf and the Blind, Staunton, Virginia, on March 6-7, 1953.

T. Carlton Lewellyn, coach and Athletic Director of the Virginia School for fifty years was the originator of the tournament; and Joseph E. Healy, Joe Shinpaugh Fred Yates and John Floyd gave their wholehearted approval and support of the tournament.

A total of 244 games have been played in the Mason-Dixon Schools for the Deaf Athletic Association Basketball Tournament since the annual event was inaugurated in Staunton.

The MDSDAA's annual tournament includes not only competition in boys' basketball, but it also includes an annual cheerleading contest which has become an exciting part of the tournament in the past several years.
