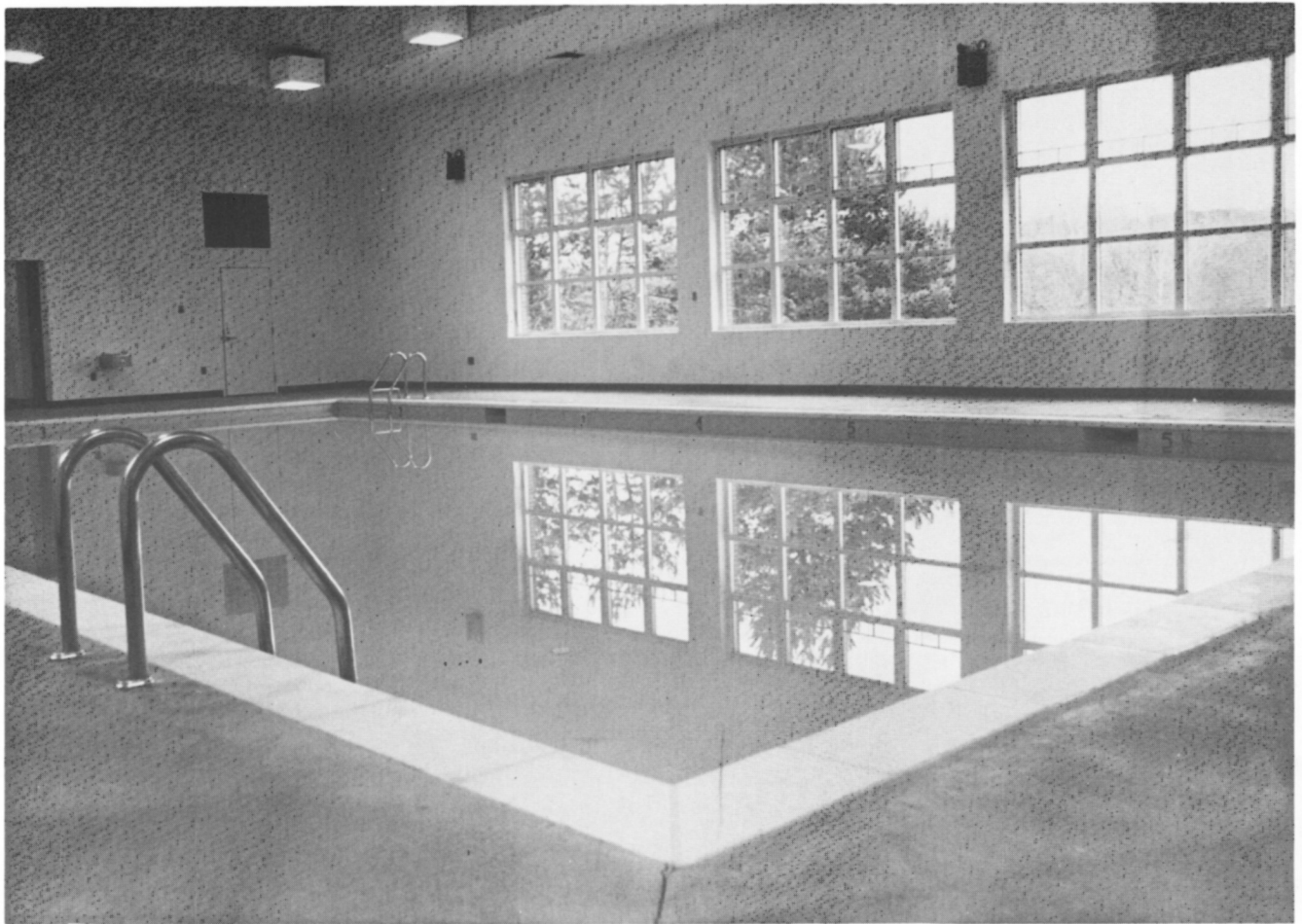

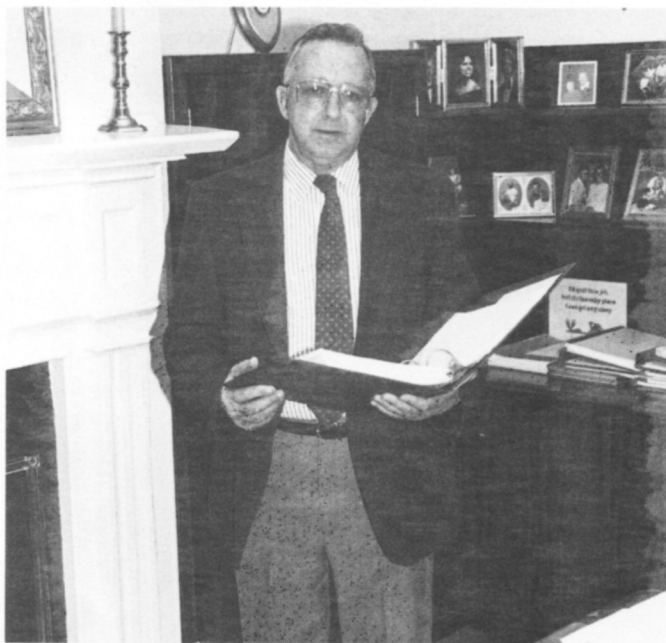
Construction of the 28 by 50-foot swimming pool began June 20 and was finished in February.

The self-contained pool is located adjacent to Lewellyn Gymnasium on the east side of the campus and was built by Fort Construction Co., of Fort Defiance. The exterior of the building is brick.

Water temperature in the year-round facility will be about 82 degrees and the depth of the pool is from 3 to 5 1/2 feet deep. The building contains an enclosed walkway from the gym to the pool building, which is 40 feet away.

The deaf and the blind students will receive swimming instruction and the pool will also be available for recreational use.

"Home Alone" grossed \$7.3 million over the weekend and has collected \$283.5 million to date, Exhibitor Relations Co. Inc. said Monday. The movie now stands above "Top Gun," "Pootsie" and "Indiana Jones and the Temple of Doom" on the all-time box-office list.
