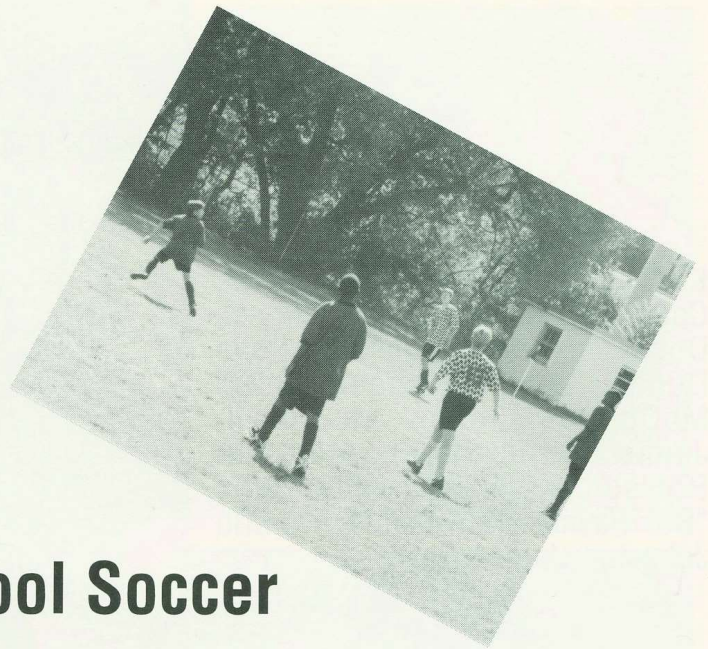
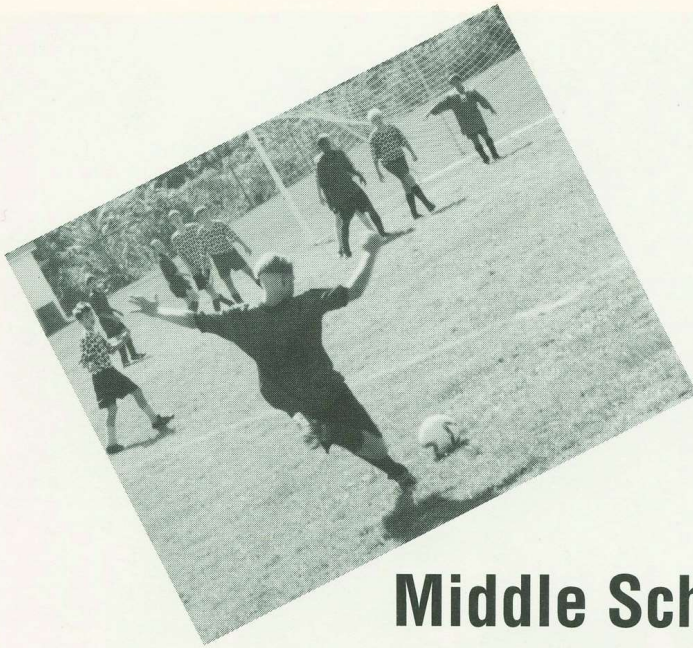
### Fall VSDB-AYSO U-12 Upper Elementary Soccer Team "The Cardinals"

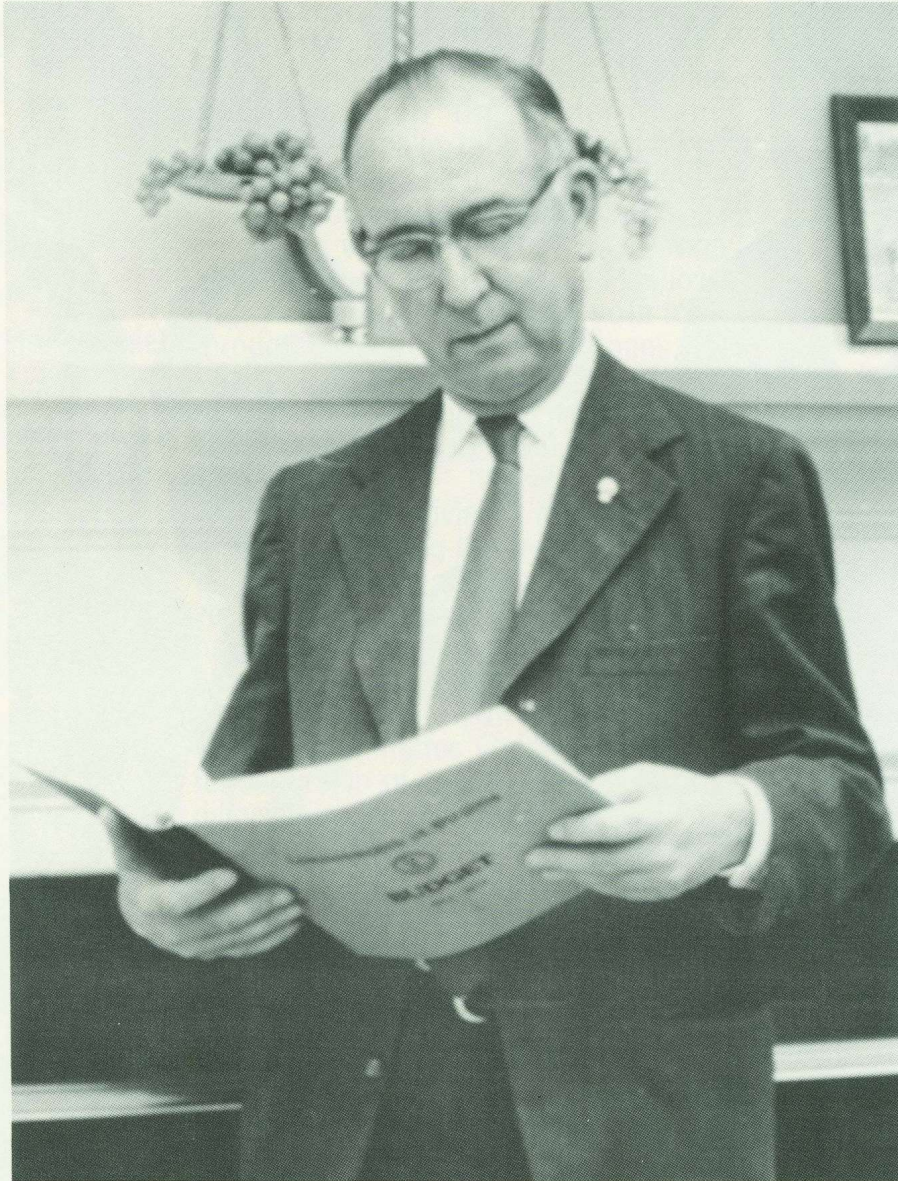
# In Memoriam



## **Mills E. Godwin, Jr. (1914 - 1999)**

Mills E. Godwin, Jr. was the only Governor who was ever elected twice by Virginia's popular vote. He had served in both houses of the General Assembly and as Lieutenant Governor previous to his first term. Godwin is remembered by the public as "the Education Governor" since he was largely responsible for the establishment of the Virginia Community College System. Godwin served as a Democrat during his first term as Governor but switched to the Republican Party for his second term. In 1970 when the School for the Deaf became a fully accredited High School for the first time in the school's history, Governor Godwin came to the school to help celebrate this memorable accomplishment. He showed time and again that he was interested in the advancement and improvement of conditions for the deaf and other persons who lacked some of life's good fortunes. It is fitting and proper that we honor his memory in the year of his passing.

# In Memoriam



**Joe R. Shinpaugh, Jr. (1916 - 1998)**

Joe R. Shinpaugh was born on August 14, 1916, at Benton, Arkansas, son of Joe and Anna (Mayer) Shinpaugh. He was a 1938 graduate of Hendrix College at Conway, Arkansas. He received Master's of Art Degrees from Columbia University at New York in 1940 and in 1941 from Gallaudet College at Washington, D.C. He was a retired Lieutenant Colonel of the Army, having served during World War II. Prior to his retirement in 1978, he was principal and then superintendent of the Virginia School for the Deaf and the Blind, serving from September 1, 1946 - June 30, 1978. Joe was a tremendous principal with a well-planned agenda. In those days the principal had a secretary only half a day (shared with the Blind school Principal) and often the light burned late in his office as he caught up on his never-ending work. Joe himself was a superb counselor and knew well how to scold or comfort a deaf child as the case might warrant. He knew child psychology inside and out. In those days before the TTY and the relay system, he had to make all the phone calls for legendary Coach Lewellyn (deaf himself) to set up games with local high schools. Joe was a VERY patient man and NEVER griped about all the telephone calls, the interpreting or other added chores he did in addition to being Principal. He knows the name of every deaf child at the school and later, when he became superintendent, he learned and remembered the names of every blind child. The Blind Alumni always invited Joe to their reunions because they truly loved and respected both deaf and blind children and adults. Joe went to many weddings to serve as interpreter for his former students. When a former student or faculty member around the state passed away and the school always arrange for someone from VSDB to attend the funeral and help comfort the family. He was that kind of man. Humanity took precedence. Joe helped establish the special education program in the Department of Education. He helped the VEA inaugurate its special education program. He helped the state Lions Club start their Eye Bank program and was involved when the University of Virginia took charge of the Ear Bank. There are many more things about Joe we could mention, but suffice to say that Joe Shinpaugh was a nonpareil! His like is to be emulated.
